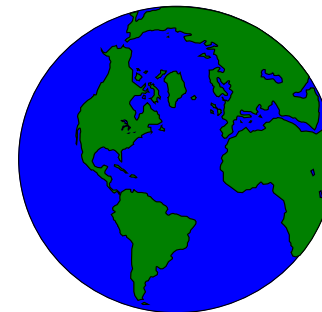

The two day Student Course runs from 7:30am to 5:00pm on both days. The Refresher Course runs from 11:30am to 5:00pm on the second day of the two-day course. Refresher only courses start at 7:30am. Participants must attend the entire session in order to receive certification.

**Course Description**

The Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS)™ Provider Course combines lectures and practical experience to teach participants to establish priorities and stabilize the critically injured patient. During the two day course, students will have the opportunity to practice their assessment techniques and their management of simulated patients in a surgical skill practicum. The ATLS course has been specifically designed for the primary care physician.

The student refresher course is a half-day course offered to those who have previously taken the ATLS course. This course must be taken within six months after the expiration of the participant's ATLS certification. *Please include a copy of your current ATLS student card with your registration.*

**Mid-level Practitioners**

Mid-levels now receive ATLS certification if registering as a student. Physician assistants and nurse practitioners may still register as auditors but will not receive an ATLS card.

**Auditors**

Others, including nurses and EMTs, must register as auditors; auditors do not receive ATLS certification.
